### ABOUT KHULUMA SIVUKE

Some of the impacts of climate change in Eswatini have been felt through the 2016/17 El Nino induced drought, which created severe acute food insecurity. The drought resulted in a number of negative health effects on all children, including an increase in severe and acute malnutrition (SAM) and stunting; decreased access to clean and safe water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) and a heightened vulnerability to violence.

UNICEF, sought a communications campaign that would provide a wholistic approach to saving lives and improving the quality of life of the most vulnerable by providing educational awareness, sustainable solutions and adequate protection, thus **Khuluma Sikuve** (Speak Out) came into being.

The campaign is supporting life-saving multi-sectoral interventions responding to the impact of climate shocks on children in Eswatini implemented by UNICEF in collaboration with the Government of Eswatini, Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) and various Implementing Partners.
